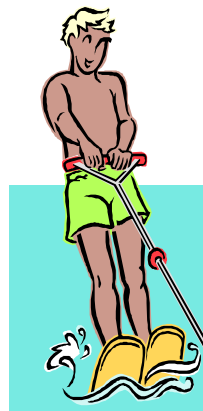
This Summer break I Want To:

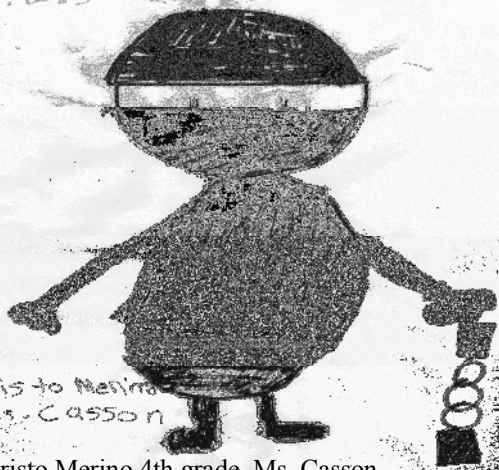
