Dragon Tales is Email ONLY!

Dragon Tales is a primarily an electronic only newsletter! DT is electronically distributed on Thursdays each week. To receive Dragon Tales send an email from the address to which you want DT sent to dragon_tales@verizon.net with “Electronic DT” in the subject line. Include your child(ren)'s name so that so that we can keep our database up to date.

Since Dragon Tales is distributed electronically, parents without computer access can request a hard copy to be sent home with their child. DT includes valuable information on both PTA and school functions and we want parents to be able to use this valuable tool. This Summer edition of Dragon Tales will be the ONLY hard copy of Dragon Tales parents will receive automatically. If parents cannot receive it electronically they should send a note to their child's teacher to request a hard copy which will then be sent home in your child's backpack. Those currently receiving DT electronically will continue to get the full color and information just as they did last year.

Olney Elementary Parking Procedures

Drop-Off/Pick-Up Safety

To ensure the safety of our children and increase the efficiency of traffic flow, please be aware of the following safety procedures:

1. Only buses are permitted in the front semi-circle during arrival and dismissal time. **DO NOT PARK IN THE BUS LANES.**
2. **SLOW DOWN!!!**
3. Student drop-off and pick-up is in the lower lot **ONLY**.
4. Enter the parking lot **ONLY** through the entrance (the one closer to the school.) **DON'T** enter through the exit (playground end). This is hazardous to our student patrols and to the cars going in the correct direction. The "Do Not Enter" sign is for everyone!
5. Please pull into the parking lot and proceed toward the end of the lot facing the playground.
6. Orange cones frame the area for drop off. Students should get out of the car on the passenger side, walk to the sidewalk and then walk to the awning by the side gym doors. Cars can then continue to drive out of the parking lot.
7. Please do not stop or block others in the parking lot area. It is important to continue to drive forward to the section where the orange cones are placed **BEFORE** stopping for drop-off.
8. If you need to get out of the car or want to escort your child(ren), please park in a parking space.
9. Park **BETWEEN** the lines! Yes, your large SUV or mini-van has room, so don't frustrate others by parking over or on the line and taking two spots in a lot where parking is tight.
10. For afternoon pick-up, you must be in a parking space to wait for your child. **DO NOT** stop in the middle of the parking lot to pick up your child.
11. Students are allowed to enter the building at 9:05 AM and car riders are dismissed at 3:28 PM
12. To pick up kindergarten walkers and car riders in the afternoon, please park, enter the school by the gym doors, and go to the school cafeteria to meet your child.

Thank you for your cooperation regarding this important safety matter.

Bus Labeling: Help Needed the 1st Day of School

Volunteers are needed on the first day of school to help our youngest students as they get off the bus. Volunteers will pin color-coded tags on our youngest students to correspond to the bus color which helps the children get on the right bus after school. Help is needed from 8:50 until 9:30 on Mon. and Tue. 8/30 and 8/31. If you are available to help or need further details, please contact Dorothea Fuller, Vice-Principal of OES.

LUNCH

We encourage you to label your child's lunch box/bag with their name and grade. This will help the Lunch Assistants locate any misplaced lunches and prevent tears during the first week of school.



In order to help parents make paying for lunch and keeping the school lunch account up-to-date, Olney ES participates with LunchMoney.com. Just go to the website and set-up your account with your child (ren)'s names and you can keep track of the balance and what they are purchasing at school for lunch. It will even send you an email when the balance is low!

When sending checks to the cafeteria for your child's lunch or snack account, please write your child's name and the account/pin number in the memo section. We are looking forward to seeing your children's smiling faces.
