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



**'LD/ADHD-24/7'** – For many children, functional difficulties created by learning disabilities and/or ADHD do not only exist at school, but follow them all day long. This talk will help participants to more thoroughly understand how the attentional, executive, and information processing difficulties in children and adolescents with ADHD and/or Learning Disabilities often impacts their functioning both in as well as outside of the classroom (in their personal, social, emotional/motivational, and family lives). Also discussed will be specific strategies and recommendations which parents and teachers can use to help our kids in the above-stated areas by capitalizing on strengths and proactively anticipating and addressing difficulties before they occur.

**Presenter:** Robert F. Chase, Ph.D., a Clinical Psychologist with more than eighteen years of experience in neuropsychology, including over ten years with William Stixrud & Associates. In 2007, Dr. Chase opened his own private practice specializing in neuropsychological, psycho-educational, and personality assessment of children, adolescents, and adults with academic, vocational, or emotional challenges. Dr. Chase has frequently lectured on topics related to assessment and treatment of ADHD, Learning Disabilities, and Executive Dysfunction, speaking at events sponsored by CHADD, The Maryland Psychological Association, and The Lab School of Washington. He regularly advises parents on obtaining the school support needed by their children and has also participated extensively in school conferences, presenting diagnostic test results and their implications for educational interventions.
